COURSES OFFERED

The Principal of The Pasiansi Wildlife Training Institute - Mwanza is announcing the following courses for the academic year 2014/2015.

1.0 TECHNICIAN CERTIFICATE IN WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT (TCWM)

This one year course begins on 1st August 2014 and ends on 20th June 2015.

1.1. Admission Requirements for the TCWM course:

- i). Candidates must have completed and passed an ordinary level (O-level) in five subjects with C in both Biology and Geography or;
- ii). Candidates with a Basic Technician Certificate in Wildlife Management (BTCWM) with a minimum GPA of 3.0 or;
- iii). Candidates with at least two years of working experience in the Wildlife sector or other relevant field
- iv). Candidates should be certified physically and mentally fit by a recognized physician. This is due to the fact that the course entails paramilitary training.

1.2. Procedures for Application for the TCWM Course:

- i). Applicants are required to submit filled application forms provided by the Institute with details of required qualifications to the Principal, attaching copies of relevant certificates. Applicants, who are employees from Wildlife Division, District Council, Tanzania National Parks (TANAPA), Ngorongoro Conservation Area Authority (NCAA), and NGOs, should submit their application forms through their employers.
- ii). Applicants will be selected according to priority based on their academic performance

1.3. Fees and other Financial Requirements for the TCWM Course:

The fee for the TCWM Course is Tsh. **3,000,000/=** per annum. The fee caters for tuition, accommodation, meals, uniform and first aid.

2.0 BASIC TECHNICIAN CERTIFICATE IN WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT (BTCWM)

This one year course begins on 1st August 2014 and ends on 20th June 2015.

2.1. Admission Requirements for the BTCWM Course:

- i). Candidates must have completed and passed an ordinary level (O-level) in five subjects with D in both Biology and Geography or;
- ii). Candidates who have completed ordinary level (O-level) education of any pass with a certificate for a three-month course in wildlife management from The Institute of Wildlife Management – Pasiansi or;
- iii). Candidates with at least two years of working experience in the Wildlife sector or other relevant field
- iv). Candidates should be certified physically and mentally fit by a recognized physician. This is due to the fact that the course entails paramilitary training.

2.2. Procedures for Application for the BTCWM Course:

- i). Applicants are required to submit filled application forms provided by the Institute with details of required qualifications to the Principal, attaching copies of relevant certificates. Applicants, who are employees of WD, District Council, TANAPA, NCAA, and NGOs, should submit their application forms through their employers.
- ii). Applicants with required entry qualifications will be notified to appear for interview at designated interview centres

2.3. Fees and other Financial Requirements for the BTCWM Course:

The fee for the BTCWM Course is Tsh. **2,800,000/=** per annum. The fee caters for tuition, accommodation, meals, uniform and first aid.

3.0 THREE-MONTH SPECIAL COURSE IN WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT

This three-month special course will begin on 16th March, 2013 ending on 24th June, 2014.

3.1 Admission Requirements for three-month special course:

- i) Candidates without direct qualifications for admission into BTCWM course (i.e. without at least D in Biology and Geography in form four results) or;
- ii) Candidates with standard seven plus relevant work experience in the Wildlife sector from WMAs, District Councils and NGOs.

2.3. Fees and other Financial Requirements for the BTCWM Course:

The fee for the Three-Month Special Course is Tsh. **1,861,000/=** per annum. The fee caters for tuition, accommodation, meals, uniform and first aid.

4.0 PLEASE NOTE:

- i). The fees paid for each of the courses cover cost for tuition, accommodation, meals, field training, uniforms, first aid, sports gear and graduation ceremony
- ii). All payments shall be done through the Institute's **Bank Account name PRINCIPAL WTI No. 31101100029 at NMB Kenyatta Road Branch** in Mwanza City.
- iii). All applicants for TCWM, BTCWM and Three-Month Short Course shall pay a non-refundable fees of **Tsh. 30,000/=** to the Institute's bank account and obtain a pay-in-slip whose copy shall be attached to the filled in application forms on submission.
- iv). The deadline of receiving the applications is **30th April 2014** for TCWM and BTCWM courses.
- v). The deadline of receiving the applications is **28th February 2014** for a Three-Month Short Course
