COURSES OFFERED IN THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2017/2018

The Principal of Pasiansi Wildlife Training Institute - Mwanza is announcing the following courses for the academic year 2017/2018.

1.0 TECHNICIAN CERTIFICATE IN WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT AND LAW ENFORCEMENT (TCWLE – NTA 5)

This one year course begins on 21st August 2017 and ends on 1st July 2018.

1.1. Admission Requirements for the TCWLE course:

- i). Candidates with Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (A.C.S.E.E) with one principal and one subsidiary OR.
- ii). Candidates with NTA 4 of Basic Technician Certificate in Wildlife Management and Law Enforcement from Pasiansi Wildlife Training Institute OR College of African Wildlife Management – Mweka.
- iii). Candidates should be certified physically and mentally fit by a recognized physician. This is due to the fact that the course entails paramilitary training.

1.2. Procedures for Application for the TCWLE Course:

- i). All applications should be channeled through NACTE Central Admission System during March/April 2017 intake by logging into www.nacte.go.tz as from 23rd January 2017.
- ii). All selected applicants shall be subjected to physical fitness assessment before confirmation by the Institute.

1.3. Fees and other Financial Requirements for the TCWLE Course:

The fees for the TCWLE Course is Tsh. **3,035,000/=** per annum. This amount caters for tuition, field trainings, accommodation, meals, uniform and first aid.

2.0 BASIC TECHNICIAN CERTIFICATE IN WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT AND LAW ENFORCEMENT (BTCWLE – NTA 4)

This one year course begins on 21st August 2017 and ends on 1st July 2018.

2.1. Admission Requirements for the BTCWLE Course:

- i). Candidates must have completed and passed Ordinary level (O-Level) with at least four (4) passes including passes in Biology and Geography.
- ii). Candidates should be certified physically and mentally fit by a recognized physician. This is due to the fact that the course entails paramilitary training

2.2. Procedures for Application for the BTCWLE Course:

- iii). All applications should be channeled through NACTE Central Admission System for the March/April 2017 intake by logging into www.nacte.go.tz as from 23rd January 2017.
- iv). All selected applicants shall be subjected to physical fitness assessment before confirmation by the Institute

2.3. Fees and other Financial Requirements for the BTCWLE Course:

The fee for the BTCWLE Course is Tsh. **2,835,000/=** per annum. This amount caters for tuition, field trainings, accommodation, meals, uniform and first aid.

3.0 THREE-MONTH SPECIAL COURSE IN WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT

This three-month course is special to build capacity of applicants working in the sector of wildlife conservation. The course entails conservation law enforcement (investigation, intelligence, prosecution, crime scene management, anti-poaching operation, paramilitary techniques, landscape navigation skills and ballistics skills).

Applicants can choose to study modules of interest depending on the field of concentration.

The targeted applicants are wildlife wardens, park rangers, Local council's wildlife officers and wardens, wma rangers, village game scouts, rangers from tourist hunting blocks companies, private wildlife ranch/zoo rangers, forest law enforcers and other conservation laws enforcers.

First intake will be done from 16th March to 16th June 2017. Second intake will be conducted from 20th September to 20th December 2017.

3.1 Admission Requirements for three-month special course:

- i). Candidates who completed and passed Ordinary level (O-Level) Or.
- ii). Candidates with standard seven plus relevant work experience in the Wildlife sector from WMAs, District Councils and NGOs.

3.2. Procedures for Application for Three Months Course:

- i). Applicants are required to submit filled application forms **provided by the Institute** with details of required qualifications to the Principal, attaching copies of relevant certificates.
- ii). Applicants, who are employees of WD, District Council, TANAPA, NCAA, and NGOs, should submit their application forms through their employers OR
- iii). Employers or Sponsors of the applicants should write a letter to The Principal specifying the area of capacity building.

3.3. Fees and other Financial Requirements for Three Months Short Course:

The fee for the Three-Month Special Course is Tsh. **1,861,000/=**. This amount caters for tuition, field trainings, accommodation, meals, uniform and first aid.

4.0 PLEASE NOTE:

- i). The fees paid for each of the courses cover cost for tuition, accommodation, meals, field training, uniforms, first aid, sports gear and graduation ceremony.
- ii). All applicants for TCWLE and BTCWLE shall apply through NACTE Central Admission System. Visit NACTE website for procedures and application.
- iii). The deadline for the applications of TCWLE and BTCWLE through NACTE CAS will be on March **2017** as stipulated by NACTE.
- iv). The physical fitness assessment will be conducted only to the selected students by CAS before confirmation by The Institute at Pasiansi Wildlife Training Institute – Mwanza on stipulated date and time by the Institute.
