INVITATION FOR APPLICATIONS FOR 2019/2020 INTAKE

Pasiansi Wildlife Training Institute (PWTI) was established in 1966 under Section 96 of the Wildlife Conservation Act No. 5 of 2009 which erstwhile was known as Fauna Conservation Ordinance of 1959. PWTI was registered in 2002 by the National Council for Technical Education (NACTE) with full accreditation to offer two programs i.e. Basic Technician Certificate in Wildlife Management and Law Enforcement (BTCWLE - NTA Level 4) and Technician Certificate in Wildlife Management and Law Enforcement (TCWLE - NTA Level 5).

The Principal is hereby inviting applications from qualified Tanzanians for the academic year 2019/2020 on the following training programs:

1.0 TECHNICIAN CERTIFICATE IN WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT AND LAW ENFORCEMENT (TCWLE – NTA 5): – One-year programme

1.1. Admission Requirements for the TCWLE course:

- i) Advanced Certificate of Secondary School Education (A.C.S.S.E) with one (1) principal and one (1) subsidiary passes, plus passes in Biology and Geography subjects at O-level. OR;
- ii) A pass of at least grade D in four (4) subjects including Biology and Geography at ordinary level (O-level) plus Basic Technician Certificate in Wildlife Management and Law Enforcement (BTCWLE) from Pasiansi Wildlife Training Institute or College of African Wildlife Management – Mweka.
- iii) A pass of at least grade D in any four (4) subjects at ordinary level (O-level) plus Basic Technician Certificate in Wildlife Management and Law Enforcement (BTCWLE) from Pasiansi Wildlife Training Institute or College of African Wildlife Management – Mweka with 2 years working experience in the field of wildlife conservation.
- iv) Candidates should be certified physically and mentally fit by a recognized physician. This is due to the fact that the course entails paramilitary training.

2.0 BASIC TECHNICIAN CERTIFICATE IN WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT AND LAW ENFORCEMENT (BTCWLE – NTA 4): – One-year programme

2.1. Admission Requirements for the BTCWLE Course:

- i) A pass of at least grade D in four subjects including Biology and Geography at ordinary level (O-level)
- ii) Candidates should be certified physically and mentally fit by a recognized physician. This is due to the fact that the course entails paramilitary training

3.0 MODE OF APPLICATION:

- i) Qualified applicants should apply for admission directly to the Institute from **15 May 2019**.
- ii) Application forms are available at Pasiansi Wildlife Training Institute, Mwanza or can be downloaded from www.pasiansiwildlife.ac.tz

- iii) Application fees of TZS 10,000 (ten thousand) must be deposited at the Institute's bank account; Account Name: **Principal Wildlife Training Institute** Account. No. **31101100029** at **NMB** (National Microfinance Bank).
- iv) All application forms must be accompanied by application fees bank pay-in slip, certified photocopies of relevant certificates, and **academic transcripts** (for TCWLE applicants with BTCWLE certificates).
- v) Applicants with foreign secondary school certificates must attach equivalent results from National Examinations Council of Tanzania (NECTA). *Incomplete applications shall not be processed.*
- vi) Applications submitted **through email** must be **PDF in one file**.
- vii) All applications must be sent to the Institute not later than **30 June 2019**. Late applications will not be considered.
- viii) Filled application forms attached with relevant documents shall be submitted at the Institute's Admissions Office, or sent via the following address: -
