 - i). No history of accident or serious ailment (disease)
 - ii). Ability to pass an entrance paramilitary medical examination
 - iii). No mental or physical disability
 - iv). No tattoos on any part of the body
 - v). No pregnancy or suckling baby (for female applicants)
- 2) Age between 18 to 24 years old (for unemployed applicants).
- 3) No record of criminal activity.
- 4) High discipline.
