2.0 Paramilitary Training Requirements:

Due to the paramilitary nature of training, applicants must have:

- 1). Physical and mental fitness as follow:
 - i). No history of accident or serious ailment (disease)
 - ii). Ability to pass an entrance paramilitary medical examination
 - iii). No mental or physical disability
 - iv). No tattoos on any part of the body
 - v). Not pregnant or breastfeeding (for female applicants)
- 2). Age between 17 to 24 years old (for unemployed applicants)
- 3). No record of criminal activity.
- 4). High discipline.

3.0 Fees Coverage:

The respective fees shown in table 1 for the courses cater for tuition, field practical training, accommodation, meals, uniform, first aid and NACTVET quality assurance.

4.0 Mode of Application:

- i). Qualified applicants should apply for admission to the Institute from **20th May 2024**.
- ii). Application forms are available at Pasiansi Wildlife Training Institute, Mwanza or can be downloaded from the Institute Website: <https://www.pasiansiwildlife.ac.tz>
- iii). A non-refundable **application fees** of **TZS 10,000/=** shall be paid through a Government **Control Number** that can be generated from <https://portal.maliasili.go.tz>, or from the Institute's Accounts Office by calling **0757 284 012**.

Procedure for obtaining control number from the website:

- a) Open <https://portal.maliasili.go.tz> in your browser
- b) Go to '**Quick services**' and fill in your *phone number* and *email address*
- c) Go to '**Chagua Kundi la Huduma**' and select '*Receipts from Miscellaneous Fees*'
- d) Go to '**Chagua huduma**' and select *Pasiansi - Application Fee - (TZS 10,000/-*
- e) Go to '**Idadi**' and input 1
- f) Press '**Ongeza**' and finally **Andaa billi**
- iv). All application forms must be accompanied by application fees bank slip or payment receipt and certified photocopies of relevant certificates.
- v). All **applicants with equivalents** i.e., with Basic Technician Certificates **should** attach **certified** copies of **original academic certificates** and **transcripts**.
- vi). Applicants with foreign secondary school certificates must attach equivalent results from National Examinations Council of Tanzania (NECTA). *Incomplete application forms shall not be processed.*
- vii). Applications submitted **through email** must be **PDF in one file** with all relevant documents.
- viii). All applications must be sent to the Institute not later than **01st July 2024**. Late applications will not be considered.
