3.0 Paramilitary Training Requirements:

Due to the paramilitary nature of training, applicants must have:

3.1 Physical and mental fitness as follows:

- 3.1.1 No history of accident, operation or serious ailment (disease)
- 3.1.2 Ability to pass an entrance paramilitary medical examination
- 3.1.3 No mental or physical disability
- 3.1.4 No tattoos anywhere on the body
- 3.1.5 Not pregnant or breastfeeding (for female applicants)

3.2 Recommended age 17 to 24 years old for NTA level 4 and 5 (for unemployed applicants) and not above 30 for applicants not aspiring for civil employment

3.3 Ability to pass criminal record check

4.0 Fees Coverage:

4.1 Fees shown in **Table 1** (NTA level 6 programs) cater for tuition, field practical training, student registration, students' union, student ID, caution money, examination, uniform and NACTVET quality assurance. **Food and accommodation for NTA level 6 programs will be upon individual students**

4.2 The fees shown in **Table 2** (NTA level 4 and 5 programs) cater for tuition, field practical training, food and accommodation, uniform, first aid and NACTVET quality assurance.

5.0 Mode of Application:

- i. Qualified and interested applicants should apply for admission to the Institute from **28th May to 20th July, 2025**.
- ii. Application forms will be available at Pasiansi Wildlife Training Institute, Mwanza or can be downloaded from the Institute's website: <https://www.pasiansiwildlife.ac.tz> from 28th May 2025.
- iii. A non-refundable **application fees** of **TZS 15,000/=** shall be paid through a

Government **Control Number** that can be obtained from [https://portal.maliasili.go.tz/ Quick Services](https://portal.maliasili.go.tz/Quick%20Services), then fill in your phone number and email address, **Kundi la Huduma** select '*Receipts from Miscellaneous Fees*', **Chagua huduma** (*Pasiansi - Application Fee - (TZS 15,000/-)*), **Idadi** (1), **Ongeza** and finally **Andaa bili** or from the Institute's Accounts Office, or by calling **+255 (0)658 027 452**.

- iv. All application forms must be accompanied by application fee bank slip or payment receipt and certified photocopies of relevant certificates.
- v. Applicants with foreign secondary school certificates must attach equivalent results from National Examinations Council of Tanzania (NECTA). *Incomplete applications shall not be processed.*
- vi. Applications submitted **through email** must be in a **PDF format and in one file** with all relevant documents.
- vii. All applications must be sent to the Institute not later than **20th July 2025**. Late applications will not be considered.
- viii. In advance do follow-up to obtain National Identification Number (NIDA), the number will be used, during enrolment.
- ix. Remember to write your **phone number** correctly and make sure the number is reachable as it will receive a registration code (**MSIMBO**) from NACTVET. It is very important to keep this code and submit it to the admission office on reporting.
