### INVITATION FOR APPLICATIONS FOR MARCH INTAKE 2026/2027

**Pasiansi Wildlife Training Institute (PWTI)** is a well-renowned centre for paramilitary training in Wildlife Management and Law Enforcement, and Tour Guiding and Tourism Safety. The Institute is fully accredited by the National Council for Technical and Vocational Education and Training (NACTVET) to offer four programs to eligible candidates. The **March 2026 Intake** will offer one program of **Basic Technician Certificate in Wildlife Management and Law Enforcement (BTCWLE)**. The admission requirements are shown in Tables 1 and 2 below:

#### 2.0 Paramilitary Training Requirements:

Due to the paramilitary nature of training, applicants must have:

##### 2.1 Physical and mental fitness as follows:

- 2.1.1 No history of accident or serious ailment (disease)
- 2.1.2 Ability to pass an entrance paramilitary medical examination
- 2.1.3 No mental or physical disability
- 2.1.4 No tattoos or major scars on any part of the body
- 2.1.5 Not pregnant or breastfeeding (for female applicants)

##### 2.2 Age between 17 and 24 years old (for unemployed applicants)

##### 2.3 No record of criminal activity.

##### 2.4 High discipline.

#### 3.0 Fees Coverage:

The fees shown in Table 1 cover tuition, field practical training, accommodation, meals, uniform, First Aid, and NACTVET quality assurance.

#### 4.0 Mode of Application:

- i). Interested qualified applicants should apply for admission from **10<sup>th</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> February 2026**.
- ii). Application forms are available at Pasiansi Wildlife Training Institute, Mwanza or can be downloaded from the Institute's website: <https://www.pasiansiwildlife.ac.tz>
- iii). A non-refundable **application fees** of **TZS 15,000/=** shall be paid through a Government **Control Number** that can be obtained from <https://portal.maliasili.go.tz/> **Quick Services**, then fill in your phone number and email address, **Kundi la Huduma** select '*Receipts from Miscellaneous Fees*', **Chagua huduma** (*Pasiansi Application Fee - (TZS 15,000/-)*), **Idadi** (1), **Ongeza** and finally **Andaa bili** or from the Institute's Accounts Office, or by calling **+255 (0)753 195 748**.
- iv). All application forms must be accompanied by application fees bank slip or payment receipt and certified photocopies of relevant certificates.
- v). Applicants with foreign secondary school certificates must attach equivalent results from National Examinations Council of Tanzania (NECTA). *Incomplete applications shall not be processed.*
- vi). Applications submitted **through email** must be **PDF in one file** with all relevant documents.
- vii). All applications must be sent to the Institute not later than **28<sup>th</sup> February 2026**. Late applications will not be considered.
- viii). National Identification Number (NIDA) will be required during enrolment.
- ix). Make sure that you provide a reliable phone number on your application form.
