3.0 Paramilitary Training Requirements:

Due to the paramilitary nature of training, applicants must have:

3.1 Physical and mental fitness as follows:

- 3.1.1 No history of accident, operation, or serious ailment (disease)
- 3.1.2 Ability to pass an entrance paramilitary medical examination
- 3.1.3 No mental or physical disability
- 3.1.4 No tattoos anywhere on the body
- 3.1.5 Not pregnant or breastfeeding (for female applicants)

3.2 Recommended age 17 to 24 years old for NTA level 4 and 5 (for unemployed applicants).

3.3 No criminal record

4.0 Fees Coverage:

4.1 Fees shown in **Table 1** (NTA level 6 programs) cater for Tuition, Field practical training, Student Registration, Students' Union, Student ID, Caution Money, Examination, Uniform, and NACTVET quality assurance. **The fee does not cater for Food and accommodation**


4.2 The fees shown in Table 2 (NTA level 4 and 5 programs) cater for Tuition, Field practical training, Food and Accommodation, Uniform, First Aid, and NACTVET quality assurance.

5.0 Mode of Application:

- i. Qualified and interested applicants should apply for admission to the Institute from **28th May to 07th July, 2026**.
- ii. The applications will be done through the **Online Application System** by **logging in** to <https://saris.maliasili.go.tz/Registration/24>, from 28th May 2026. This link is also available on www.pasiansiwildlife.ac.tz
- iii. A non-refundable **application fee** of **TZS 15,000/=** shall be paid through a Government **Control Number** that will be obtained from the online application system.
- iv. Applicants with foreign secondary school certificates must obtain equivalent results from the National Examinations Council of Tanzania (NECTA).
- v. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- vi. The deadline for applications is **07th July 2026**.
- vii. The National Identification Number (NIDA), which will be required during enrolment.
- viii. During Application, please provide a correct applicant **contact number** that is accessible anytime, so that you will receive a registration code (**MSIMBO**) from NACTVET. It is very important to keep this code and submit it to the admission office upon reporting.
