1. Registration process

All candidates are required to submit the following documents during registration:

- a) All payments must be made using a **Control Number** generated by the Institute for each student. Please note that all **FEES ONCE PAID ARE NON-REFUNDABLE**.

- ii) Original and certified copies of their birth certificates, academic transcripts, and certificates. The original documents will be returned after thorough physical verification.
- iii) Proof of Health Insurance Scheme. Those who do not possess a health insurance scheme shall pay for a Student NHIF scheme amounting to TZS 50,400.
- iv) Two stamp-size or passport-size photographs (coloured)
- v) Candidates must renew their registration at the beginning of every semester and pay the required fees. Failure to renew registration shall lead to automatic discontinuation from studies.
- vi) Candidates will be registered by names appearing on their academic certificates. No change of names shall be entertained during the course of study at the Institute.

2. Personal effects for physical training, parade, and field activities.

- i). One pair of complete/full black leather military boots, preferably from Karanga Leather Industries Ltd. (sample available at the Institute)
- ii). One pair of rubber shoes “raba” for jogging and physical training.
- iii). One pair of forest/jungle/dark green tracksuits with white/yellow stripes for sports.
- iv). Two pairs of thick black socks (to be worn with boots) and two pairs of light green long socks (to be worn with sports shoes).
- v). Black shoe polish and a shoe brush.
- vi). One army green sweater.
- vii). Black official shoes
- viii). Short-sleeved khaki shirt and a pair of khaki trousers (*provided by the Institute*)
- ix). Two collared T-shirts (*provided by the Institute*)
- x). One pair of PWTI Combat (*provided by the Institute*)

3. Personal Emoluments and other financial payments

- i). Employed students are advised to make all necessary arrangements with their employers regarding the receipt of their emoluments and other payments before reporting for training. No permission will be granted to students to pursue such payments.
- ii). Private students must also ensure that prior arrangements are in place to facilitate the timely receipt of funds from parents or sponsors for their basic needs. These arrangements should eliminate the need to request leave for financial matters during the course.

4. Accommodation

The Institute does not offer accommodation for Diploma students. Students are encouraged to independently arrange their accommodation requirements. To secure convenient and affordable accommodation, we strongly recommend that students begin their accommodation search well in advance

5. Cafeteria services

Please be informed that the Institute does not provide meals for Diploma students. Students are therefore responsible for making their own meal arrangements. We encourage you to plan to ensure your nutritional needs are adequately met during your studies.

6. Student dress code

As per the Public Service Circular No. 3 of 2007 regarding dress code, students are expected to wear the Institute's official uniform at all times during weekdays. During field practical training and parade sessions, students shall wear a full combat.

Therefore, students need to procure essential items listed under personal effects to complement the uniforms provided. **Failure to comply with the dress code shall result in disciplinary action.**
